

## 2020 Primary Election 3 Easy Steps to Vote-by-Mail



*All voters are **strongly encouraged** to Vote by Mail. If you go to a polling location on July 7<sup>th</sup> Primary Day, you will only be allowed to vote using a provisional (paper) ballot.*




## What You Will Receive in the Mail

If you are an *active* registered Republican or Democrat voter, you will automatically receive a Vote-by-Mail ballot like this in the mail.

The envelope will contain these three pieces needed to complete your vote:

1. Ballot
2. Internal envelope
3. Postage-paid return envelope





## STEP 1: Complete your ballot

- **IMPORTANT:** Use ONLY BLACK or BLUE ink, or PENCIL
- Indicate your votes by filling in the correct bubbles for each Office Title next to the candidate's name in Republican Column 1
- If you prefer to vote for any person not printed on the ballot, write that person's name in the Write-In Column and fill in the correct bubble

**To Protect Your Vote:**  
 IT IS AGAINST THE LAW FOR ANYONE EXCEPT YOU THE VOTER TO MARK OR INSPECT THIS BALLOT.  
 However, a family member may assist you in doing so.

**IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS TO VOTERS**  
 Please read the following before marking your ballot:

1. Use **ONLY** a pencil or ink pen (black or blue) to mark your ballot. Do not use red ink.
2. Completely fill in oval to the right of each of your selections.  
  
 MARK BALLOT LIKE THIS:

3. To vote for any person whose name is not printed on this ballot, go to the Write-In Column and darken the oval by the words "write-in" for the office in which you want to write-in. Write the name of the person for which you wish to vote on the blank line.
4. If you tear, deface or incorrectly mark this ballot, return it to the Morris County Clerk's Election Office and obtain a new ballot.

## STEP 2a: Insert and seal completed ballot in interior envelope

- If anyone provided assistance in completing your ballot, he/she should complete this section
- Insert your ballot and make sure to seal the ballot securely in the interior envelope

**DO NOT TEAR OFF THIS FLAP**

Any person providing assistance shall complete the following:

I do hereby certify that I am the person who provided assistance to this voter and declare that I will maintain the secrecy of this ballot.

BE SURE TO SEAL

**PENALTY FOR FRAUDULENT VOTING**

*A PERSON MAY BE FINED AND IMPRISONED AND MAY ALSO LOSE THE RIGHT TO VOTE UNTIL RESTORED BY LAW if that person attempts to vote fraudulently by mail-in ballot, prevents the voting of a legal voter, certifies falsely any information, interferes with a person's secrecy of voting, tampers with ballots or election documents or helps another person to do so.*



## STEP 2b: Sign the *Certificate of Mail-In Voter* on interior envelope

- **IMPORTANT!:** Sign the Certificate of Mail-In Voter here
- The #1 reason ballots are rejected is due to voters not signing the certification!
- DO NOT DETACH the flap!

**FOR YOUR VOTE TO COUNT,**  
THE MOST YOU CAN GET IS TWO ENVELOPES AND

**CERTIFICATE OF MAIL-IN VOTER**

I, the undersigned, whose name, address and municipality appear on this certificate, DO HEREBY CERTIFY, subject to the penalties for fraudulent voting, that I am the person who applied for the enclosed ballot for the Primary Election. I MARKED AND SEALED THIS BALLOT AND CERTIFICATE IN STRICT PRIVACY. A family member may assist me in doing so.

**INSTRUCTIONS TO MAIL-IN VOTER**

- 1) Vote your ballot and place it in THIS certificate envelope with the attached certificate.
- 2) Seal THIS envelope. SIGN the certificate.
- 3) Place THIS envelope into the RETURN, larger envelope addressed to the Board of Elections and seal that envelope.
- 4) If another person will be making your ballot or bringing it to the Board of Elections, make certain that person completes the "Bequer Pledge" on the envelope addressed to the Board of Elections before the ballot is taken from you. No Person who is a candidate in the election for which the voter requests this ballot is permitted to serve as a signer. No person is permitted to serve as a signer for more than three qualified voters in an election.
- 5) Mail to the County Board of Elections as soon as possible. All mail-in ballots returned by mail MUST BE POSTMARKED ON OR BEFORE the day of the election AND RECEIVED by the Board of Elections within 68 hours after the polls close.
- 6) If you wish to hand deliver your ballot, the Board of Elections is located at 18 Court Street, 3rd floor, Morristown, NJ 07960. All ballots returned in person MUST BE RECEIVED by the Board of Elections by the close of polls on election day.


### STEP 3: Insert your ballot into the postage-paid return envelope and return via USPS or by dropping in a secure VBM ballot drop-box location

**IMPORTANT:** Insert your ballot so that your name appears in this window

The drop-box locations closest to Harding Township are located at:

- **Morristown:** Morris County Administration & Records Building at 10 Court Street (outside front entrance)
- **Madison:** Hartley Dodge Memorial Building at 50 Kings Road (behind police headquarters)

**IMPORTANT:** Your Vote-by-Mail ballot must be postmarked or dropped in a ballot box no later than July 7<sup>th</sup> Primary Day.


